Education

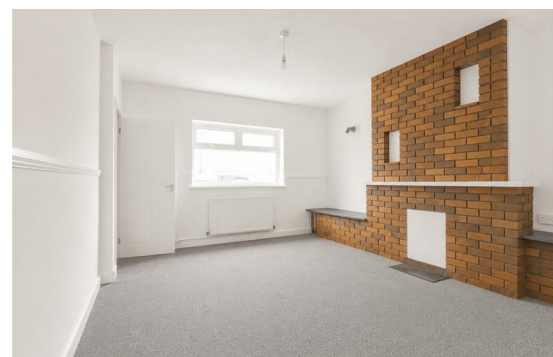
